Reality TV star's fake boob shock

A REALITY TV star has told of her shock at discovering she has potentially dangerous breast implants.

The Only Way Is Essex star Lauren Pope said she got a late-night call to tell her that her implants were made by PIP and that she may need an operation to remove them.

She told STV's Tonight programme: "The lady that works for my surgeon rang me quite late at night ... and I thought, 'Oh God, it's not going to be good news.'"

About 40,000 British women received French-made implants, which were filled with non-medical grade silicone.

Pope said: "I just thought, like, how the hell has this happened?"

The programme will be broadcast tonight.

Peddalling untruths

CLIMATE campaigners who accuse the SNP of breaking their promises to cyclists drive home their message in Edinburgh.

About 350 activists gathered outside Scottish Government offices at St Andrew's House yesterday.

active and sustainable travel".
